

### 57% of market players agree that PSD2 achieved intended results but there are few critical points still to address

Balance between investments sustained and revenues generated (e.g. API Premium)

Weak UX due to fragmented AIS & PIS customer journey flows

SCA implementation features resulting in complex and different UX

Complexity on technological implementation (e.g. API, SCA) and process integration

Still different national practices (e.g. scope of payments data, authorization process)

Lack of a full standardization in API exposure and communication interfaces

**Exclusion** of **providers** from the **scope** of the Directive (e.g. TSP)

Weak diffusion of cross-border vs. domestic payments

Rising challenges in managing emerging fraud trends


